We continue to be blown away by the reception of offering free movie nights in downtown for our community.





We handed out over 17,000 pieces of ice creams at various events in our city.


CITY GENEROSITY Financials

In 2022, we saw 514,567.77 given directly to the renovations at 220 E. Solomon St. Of the amount raised, \$101,000 has been spent on architectural documents, plans, and immediate renovations needed. The remainder has been placed in savings noted to building renovations.
